Purpose:


The Farm Hand is a vital part of the Farming team at Hosanna Farmstay. This role is essential as it ensures that the farming operations of our farmstay are carried out in the most effective and efficient manner while also providing access to our guests to a safe and enjoyable farm environment.

The Farm Hand ensures that our farming environment is maintained in a presentable and safe way, and that guest farm facilities are always easily accessible by our guests.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Assist the Farm Manager in the day-to-day operations of the farm, including;
 - Movement of animals (daily cattle rotations, pastured chickens, pastured pigs)
 - o Running out temporary electric fencing for cattle, chickens and pigs
 - Overseeing feeding of all farm animals
- Maintaining feed supplies for all animals
- Assisting with training of staff and volunteers in animal management
- Facilitating animal feeding demonstrations and other interactive activities
- Fencing
 - o Building new fences
 - Maintaining and repairing existing fences
 - Conducting fence inspections
 - Installing new gates
 - Maintaining and repairing gate hardware
- Paddock observations and pasture rotation management
 - Conducting feed estimates
 - Developing 1-4 week feed rotations for livestock
 - o Organising supplemental feed when required
- Constructing and/or installing new animal management facilities including;
 - Fixed & Semi-fixed shelters
 - o Mobile Shelters
 - Waterers and water lines
 - Feeders and feed storage facilities
- Incubation Program

- Monitoring incubating eggs
- Collecting eggs for incubation



- Care for chicks
- Animal Welfare
 - \circ Cattle treatments and inspections in cattle yard
 - Liaising with vet and other specialists in developing and carrying out best practice animal welfare programs
- Produce/Market Gardens
 - Maintaining Compost
 - Operating and giving instruction in the use of the mulcher
 - Working in the Greenhouse to raise seedlings
 - o Irrigation maintenance
 - o Harvesting and weeding when required
- Butchering program

 - Assisting with onsite chicken processing
