

# DOGS RULE



Hosanna allows pets but with this in mind, there are several basic rules you need to observe. All pets must be declared at check-in time at reception and you will be asked to sign the Dog Rules document.

Use discretion in communal areas such as the dining room. Some people may not like to have a dog present while they are eating. Dogs are not allowed in the kitchens or reception/cool room area. **DOGS MUST NOT BE IN THE DAM AREA** except before 8-30am and between 4-30 and 5-30 pm. Dogs must not go on the tyres or kayaks.

Hosanna reserves the right to refuse certain types of dogs. If you're planning on bringing your dog, please advise us of the breed and character.

Dogs must be under **their owner's** supervision at all times. In consideration of all guests, pets must be attended to and on a leash **or** under control at all times.

Dogs must not be allowed to chase the chickens, cows or horses or other animals.

Pets may be left alone tied outside a cabin, hut, tent or vehicle (with adequate shade and water) while you are offsite, if you know they will not bark excessively, but must not be left to run free.

Animals that pose a health or safety risk may not remain onsite. These include those that cause damage to our property or that of other guests, are too disruptive, are not properly attended, or demonstrate undue aggression.

Dogs are not to sleep inside the huts and cabins. They may sleep on the verandahs of the cabins. Do not allow dogs to scratch fly screens.

Excessive barking will not be tolerated. If you can't be reached on the mobile number you have given us, we will call the local Council Ranger.

Please be considerate of other guests when walking pets on the property. Your dog's droppings must be picked up, and disposed of, if they are on a public thoroughfare.

If you and your pet do not comply with any of the above guidelines, you may be asked to vacate the property with or without a refund.

We appreciate your cooperation and look forward to your stay.
